# **NEXUS 20/21 Presentation and Video Instructions**

For each presentation, the authors should submit a video:

- 1. Full Presentation: 8 to 10-minute video presentation that covers the main aspects of the paper.
- 2. Short Presentation/Exhibition: 4 to 5-minute video presentation that shows the main ideas/objects like in an exhibition

The deadline for submission is June 14, 2021.

#### Video format

The papers will be presented in two stages:

- 1. The pre-recorded 8 to 10-minute video or 4 to 5-minute video will be available on an internal area of the NEXUS 20/21 website, starting about two weeks before the online conference. Each registered participant will get a login for the internal area.
- 2. At least one author from every paper have to present the paper **live** in the respective session during the online conference (9-minute presentation or 4-minute short presentation/exhibition). There will be a moderated discussion at the end of each session of all presentations of the session (https://nexus2021.architektur.uni-kl.de/program).

### Video requirements

Please prepare carefully your video according to the following requirements:

Video format: .mp4 Frame rate: 30fps

Aspect ratio: 16:9/Widescreen.

Duration of Video Presentation: between 8 and 10 minutes for Full Presentation and maximum 5 minutes for Short Presentation/Exhibition.

Maximum resolution: 1920x1080 (i.e., 1080p full HD).

Audio: Please try to record in a quiet room with a high quality microphone/headset.

Slide template: We suggest the use of the NEXUS 20/21 Presentation Template for the presentation and the video.

Copyrighted materials: Do not include copyrighted materials that you do not own or you have to ask for the copyright.

# Video recording suggestions

Before recording the video, please consider the following suggestions:

- Please show your face throughout the presentation to reach a personal atmosphere.
- Remember to look at the camera, instead of your screen. Maintain eye contact with your audience.
- Close all programs, except those needed for your presentation.
- Clear your desktop if you need to change between your presentation and other software during the video recording.
- Start your video by introducing yourself with your name, affiliation, and the title of your presentation.

There are several options to record your presentation, we point here to two:

- 1. You can use **Microsoft Office PowerPoint** by using: Record Slide Show: Record a slide show with narration and slide timings.
- 2. Recording in **Zoom**: you can make your own Video Conference in Zoom and record it.

You can use other Video recording software like Panopto, ....

The videos must be sent via WeTransfer to the NEXUS 20/21 organizers.

You can send the recordings at your earliest convenience and no later than June 14, 2021.
